David also serves as the co-chair for AAEL's Drawback and Duty Deferral Committee, as the vice chair for the NCBFAA's Drawback Subcommittee, and as co-chair of the Legislative Committee for the NCBFAA.

David actively discusses drawback with congressional representatives from NJ and NY, and the U.S. Trade Representative's office.
