Lina Bucci was named Magna's Vice President of Quality in June 2020. In this role, Bucci and her global team work closely with Magna's 300+ manufacturing facilities to ensure Magna's quality principles are being upheld, with the ultimate goal of continual improvement, people development and striving for Quality excellence by exceeding our customer expectations.

Bucci previously held the position of Global Director of Quality for Magna's Mechatronics, Mirrors, and Lighting product group. In this role, she oversaw 65 manufacturing plants across 19 different countries. During this time, Bucci was also responsible for development and enforcement of quality assurance policies and procedures, collaboration with other members of management to develop improvements at a global scale, and the preparation of product and process quality reports by collecting, analyzing, and summarizing information and trends.

Prior to her role of Global Director of Quality, Bucci was Magna's Corporate Quality Manager for North America and held various roles from Quality Systems and Supplier Manager to Quality Manager at several locations.

Bucci joined Magna in 1993 immediately following her time spent as a student studying law – which served as a steppingstone to a career in Quality specifically with adherence to government and customer specific regulations.

Lina is an AIAG Steering Committee member and also a member of both Magna and MEMA's Diversity and Inclusion Councils. In 2025, she was named an Automotive News 100 Leading Woman – an award that highlights leaders driving innovation, manufacturing, and business strategy.
