- Any concerning and/or positive trends (best practices) in EV related technologies

#### **Presentation Types:**

Absolutely no commercial, sales pitches or endorsements will be considered or allowed in presentations. Time slot for each presentation is 45 minutes including Q&A. Workshop length will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

### Deadline for submission is March 15, 2024

#### **Review of Proposals**

Proposals will be reviewed by the AIAG Quality Summit Planning Committee for acceptance based on relevance, demonstrated application, and innovation. Priority will be given to presentations that are based on automotive OEM or supplier case studies or include a hands-on workshop. There is no limit to the number of proposals you can submit. *Authors of accepted proposals will be advised by April 19, 2024, and provided further directions at that time.* **Speakers will be expected to submit their rough draft in PowerPoint format to AIAG no later than July 26th, 2024.**

6. For workshop proposals, provide a detailed description of the content, learning objectives, and duration.

10. Benefit to the target audience (150 words maximum)
11. Author biography (100 words maximum)
